DSBN Reach Ahead Credits:



COBS Bread Dough Raiser Program

The John Marshall School Council will be participating in the Cobs Bread Dough Raiser program. The Dough Raiser program is how we help raise money for our school!

We will be offering a "Loaf a Month" Card for students to sell to families and friends from April 9th to April 19th, 2024. The cards will be sold for \$25 each and will be available to purchase on School Cash Online. The card is valid for one free loaf of any kind of loaf in the bakery every month for a year (12 free loaves). The purchaser of the card gets to choose any loaf they desire each and every month for a year. The cost per loaf works out to just over \$2/loaf with the school earning half that back! (cards will go home the week of April 22)

The value of the card depends on what Loaf is chosen but to give you a sense of the value, our white and whole wheat loaves cost \$4.60 and our most expensive loaf costs \$8.75 so whoever purchases the card could see savings of anywhere from \$30 to \$80 over the year!

How does it work / Rules?

The cardholder will come into the bakery every month and will choose any loaf available that day and will get it as a "Complimentary Loaf". Their card will be stamped at that time and they will not be charged for the loaf. The process will repeat itself every month until the card has been stamped for every month.

Only one card can be used per person per day. You can not come in with two cards on the same day and ask for two free loaves. You can't come in with a second card belonging to a friend and ask to pick up their free loaf as well as your own. ONLY ONE CARD CAN BE USED PER CUSTOMER PER DAY. You can't leave the bakery and come back the same day asking for a second free loaf. Each card can only be used once per day meaning you can't use it and then give it to someone else to come in the same day to get a second free loaf on the same day.

If you miss a month and come into the bakery with a missing stamp, you will still get your free loaf for the missing month. All 12 months will be allowed to be redeemed. The only restriction is that only one free loaf will be given per visit (same day) to the bakery. You can't come in asking to get the month you missed and the current month for free on the same day. You can come back the next day and we will give you the loaf on your next visit.

The cards will be valid for 14 months after purchase.

The bakery address is 7-111 Fourth Avenue, St.Catharines, and is located at the corner of Fourth Avenue and Martindale in the same plaza as Lina Linguini's, Dollarama, Meridian Credit Union, and Ren's Pets.

This card can only be used at the COBS Bread Ridley Square location in St.Catharines. It will not be honoured at any other COBS Bread location.
